



Sworn Statement Form - Conflicts of Interest

CONFLICT OF INTEREST

If you have more than one type of disclosure, complete a separate Sworn Statement Form for each type of disclosure. Multiple disclosures of one type may be stated on the same Sworn Statement Form.

I am providing a sworn statement for the following conflict of interest (check the box that applies):

- **1. Compensation for Assistance in Transaction Involving County (Utah Code Section 17-16a-5).**

An elected official or appointed employee with this type of conflict must file a sworn statement with the County Council or the body on which they are a member giving the information required by Utah Code Section 17-16a-5(6)(a)-(c), and the elected official or appointed employee must disclose this information in an open meeting to the members of the County Council or body of which they are a member. Elected officials will also need to file the sworn statement with the county clerk. The sworn statement shall be filed with the County Council 10 days prior to the date of any agreement between the county elected official or appointed employee and the person or business entity being assisted or 10 days prior to the receipt of compensation by the business entity.

- **2. Interest in Business Entity Regulated by the County (Utah Code Section 17-16a-6).**

For this type of conflict, an elected official or appointed employee must file this sworn statement with the Cache County Council. Elected officials will also need to file the sworn statement with the county clerk. This statement does not need to be filed for instances where the value of the interest is less than \$2,000, and life insurance policies and annuities may not be considered in determining the value of the interest.

Under Cache County Code and Utah Code, this disclosure is required to be made publicly when the elected official or appointed employee is first appointed or elected and during the January of each year thereafter.

- **3. Interest in Business Entity Doing Business with County (Utah Code Section 17-16a-7)**

The statement required for this conflict shall be disclosed publicly to the County Council or body on which they are a member immediately prior to any discussion by such body matters relating to such business entity, the nature of their interest in that business entity. The disclosure statement shall be entered in the minutes of the meeting. Elected officials will also need to file a sworn statement describing the conflict of interest with the county clerk.

- 4. Investment Creating Conflict of Interest with Duties (Utah Code Section 17-16a-8)**

The statement required for this conflict of interest shall be disclosed in the same manner in which number 2 conflicts are disclosed (76-16a-6).

I am a financial and managing partner in the EVO Training Facility company. Up until January 2025, there was no known conflict of interest between my roles at the County and with EVO. However, in January 2025, my partners voted to contact local governments for potential substantial involvement in supporting or buying out the company. At this point, a conflict was created. So I informed our County Executive, our HR Director, and our Development Services staff of the conflict and that I would no longer have any substantial involvement in the Cache County Development Services administration of the recreation center feasibility study. Additionally, this conflict could affect future RAPZ Tax requests, but no known conflict exists there presently.
