2. Event organizers must comply with the information as submitted in the Special Event application.
3. Public safety will be handled as outlined in the application; the Cache County Sheriff's Office will not be staffing the event.
4. Event organizers, support vehicles, and riders must yield to and allow access for emergency vehicles as necessary.
5. Riders must adhere to all traffic laws and ride with a maximum of two riders abreast at any time.
6. The event is scheduled during fire season. If a wildfire occurs during the event, the event may be subject to road closures and evacuations.
7. Applicant must coordinate with individual jurisdictions where the event crosses from unincorporated County into an incorporated municipality or another county and utilizes any facilities outside the county jurisdiction. This permit applies only to the unincorporated areas and/or facilities (i.e., roads) of the county.

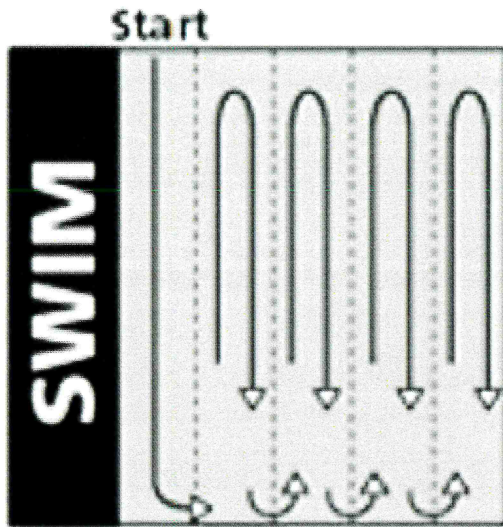
Application Deadline: Completed application forms must be submitted to the Cache County Development Services Office forty-five (45) calendar days before an event is scheduled to take place. This allows sufficient time for evaluation of the application. Late applications shall be denied unless the applicant demonstrates that compliance with the 45 day deadline was impractical or impossible due to the nature of the event. A special event permit application may be approved and a permit issued to the applicant by the Director upon approval by all the agencies specified in Section 8.40.40.

Authority: Cache County has no authority to approve permits for events other than in the unincorporated area of Cache County. Permits issued by Cache County apply only to the unincorporated area of the county, and if an event crosses into a municipality within Cache County or across the county line, applicants should determine if a permit is necessary in the other jurisdiction.

Right to Deny: Cache County reserves the right to deny permit applications for proposed special events which may pose, or have posed a significant danger or threat to the public health, welfare or safety, or which may result in unreasonable inconvenience or cost to the public. In the event the application is denied, the applicant may appeal to the Cache County Executive.

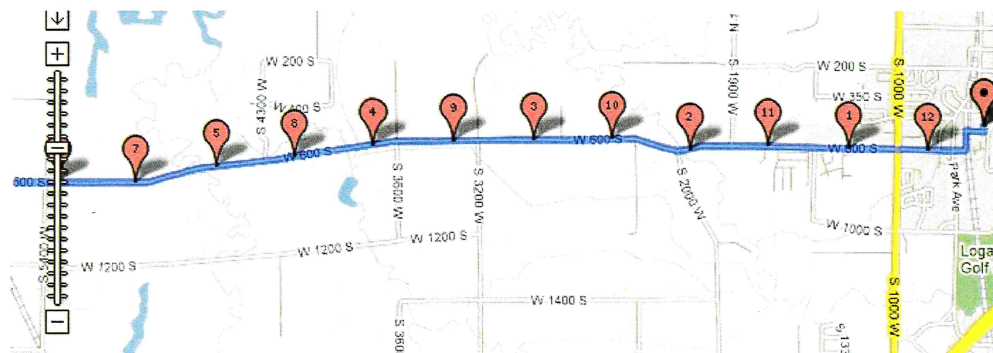
Course Maps

Swim Course



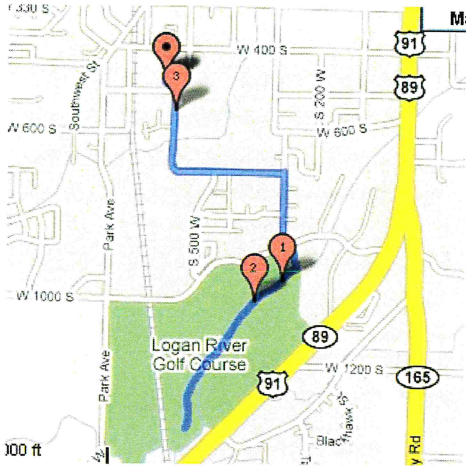
Swim Course – 500 Meters This is a serpentine swim. The swimmers enter the water on the Southwest portion of the pool one at a time in order of the fastest to the slowest to help prevent passing. You will swim up one side of the lane and down the other side. The middle portion of each lane is reserved for passing. Lane Lines will be in the water to keep swimmers on track and flip turns are allowed. Some first time triathletes ask if it is allowed to grab the side of the pool and rest. The answer is YES however if you for see that this may be the case please be the last in the pool to not block other swimmers. Olympic will repeat this swim after they have completed the Swim, Bike, Run.

Bike Course



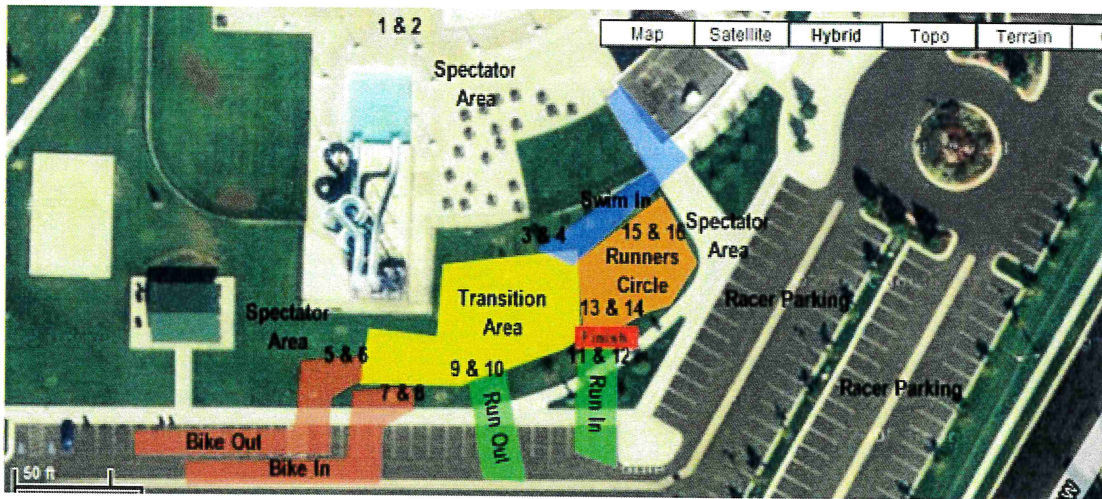
The Bike Course is flat and straight. 12.5 Miles There is only two turns on the course and they are right at the start/finish of the course. The biggest danger on the course is at the start near 1000 West. Please pay attention to police and volunteers during the first two intersections so you have a great race. There is nothing that slows down your bike time worse than being hit by a car. Pay attention and listen!!! The Olympic is repeated after you do the Swim, Bike, Run, Swim then repeat the Bike. Remember this course for the Olympic is Swim, Bike, Run, and Swim, Bike, Run again!

Run Course



The Run Course is 3.1 Miles. This course is out and back and runs in a beautiful area in Logan River Golf Course under a canopy of trees. This course follows a river. There is an aid station at around Mile 1 on the course which is repeated on the way back around Mile 2. It has water and Powerade. Make sure you pay attention to volunteers and signs and spray chalk on the course.

Transition Area



The Transition Area is a fenced in bike rack area. Swimmers will enter in via the Swim In and then grab their bike and head out the bike out and return in the bike in. Once they return their bike they will head out the Run out and return at the finish or for the Olympic reenter the transition area and head back out of the Swim In back to the pool to repeat the entire course again.

Hello,

My name is Jacqui Shelton and I'm now managing the Mass Gathering Permit. I reviewed the upcoming special events to determine if any have need for a Mass Gathering Permit and have determined that only the Little Red Riding Hood Bike Ride needs one, and they've already gone through the permitting process. The following are my notes for each event if you'd like more details.

Let me know if you have any questions.

May 14- Smithfield Health Days Fun Run- No Mass Gathering permit necessary. 450 people are reported to be in attendance (participants, volunteers, spectators, and staff). Mass Gathering permit is needed when 1000 people are in assembly for 2 or more hours in an area not designed for that occupancy or use.

May 21 - Cow-A-Bunga Race- No Mass Gathering permit necessary. About 100 people are expected to be in attendance (participants, volunteers, spectators, and staff).

June 4- 16 Crossings Trail Run- No Mass Gathering permit necessary. 150 people are expected to be in attendance (participants, volunteers, spectators, and staff).

June 4- Little Red Riding Hood Bike Ride- Does need a Mass Gathering permit, and one was mailed out on 3/10/2022.

June 11- Ragnar Spring Wasatch Back- No Mass Gathering permit necessary. Spoke with Julia Bullard on the phone, given the way they are staggering the start a mass gathering permit won't be necessary (high end estimation of 300 people at the start at any given time).

June 18- Logan Peak Trail Run- No Mass Gathering permit necessary. 195 people are expected to be in attendance (participants, volunteers, spectators, and staff).

June 25- Bike MS- No Mass Gathering permit necessary. 985 people are expected to be in attendance (participants, volunteers, spectators, and staff).

July 9- Cache Valley Super Sprint Triathlon 17th Annual- No Mass Gathering permit necessary. Less than 250 people are expected to be in attendance (participants, volunteers, spectators, and staff).

September 17- Top of Utah Marathon- No Mass Gathering permit necessary. The event is anticipating 1000 participants, but they will not be in the same place for 2 or more hours as the races will be staggered.

The Cache Valley Super Sprint Triathlon event does not present a problem for Fire and EMS as long as the riders adhere to all traffic laws.

In the past there has been a problem in other events where bike riders were riding more than two abreast and not yielding to emergency vehicles when they were responding to an emergency.

I would advise that the riders be reminded to ride no more than two abreast and to yield to emergency vehicles.
