Application Deadline: Completed application forms must be submitted to the Cache County Development Services Office forty-five (45) calendar days before an event is scheduled to take place. This allows sufficient time for evaluation of the application. Late applications shall be denied unless the applicant demonstrates that compliance with the 45 day deadline was impractical or impossible due to the nature of the event. A special event permit application may be approved and a permit issued to the applicant by the Director upon approval by all the agencies specified in Section 8.40.40.

Authority: Cache County has no authority to approve permits for events other than in the unincorporated area of Cache County. Permits issued by Cache County apply only to the unincorporated area of the county, and if an event crosses into a municipality within Cache County or across the county line, applicants should determine if a permit is necessary in the other jurisdiction.

Right to Deny: Cache County reserves the right to deny permit applications for proposed special events which may pose, or have posed a significant danger or threat to the public health, welfare or safety, or which may result in unreasonable inconvenience or cost to the public. In the event the application is denied, the applicant may appeal to the Cache County Executive.

PROJECT REVIEW PROCESS

- The applicant is encouraged to meet with staff prior to the deadline date to discuss the project and ensure that the information submitted is sufficient to provide a complete review of the project.
 - After the application is accepted, information packets are sent to various departments, agencies, and affected municipalities that provide comments and/or approval for the proposed event to the Director of Development Services.
 - In some instances a pre-event meeting may be held with planning staff and representatives from the departments and agencies that provide comments on the project review. Any issues present on a project will be discussed with the appropriate department or agency.
 - A draft permit is made available to the reviewing agencies, affected municipalities, staff, and the applicant.
 - Following agency/department review and approval, and correction of any outstanding concerns/issues, the permit can be issued.

The LoToJa Bicycle Classic is a 200-plus mile, one-day amateur bicycle road race from Logan, Utah to Jackson Hole, Wyoming. It is always scheduled in September, the first Saturday after Labor Day, and attracts national and international participants. LoToJa is one of the longest one-day road cycling races in the U.S., and is the longest one-day race sanctioned by USA Cycling, the sport's governing body based in Colorado Springs, CO. The race began in 1983 and will mark its 44th edition in 2026.

LoToJa is pronounced "low-to-juh" by some and "la-toe-juh" by others. It starts at the Sunrise Cyclery bike shop in Logan, Utah and heads north into southeastern Idaho and winds north up through western Wyoming. The finish line is near the base of the Grand Teton at Jackson Hole Mountain Resort (Teton Village, WY), one of America's top ski destinations. Along the incredibly scenic course are three mountain passes, plus hilly to rolling terrain that results in nearly 10,000 feet of vertical climbing.

LoToJa attracts a variety of male and female riders, from top-level amateur racers who are licensed by USA Cycling, to recreational cyclists who just want to cross the finish line and live to tell the tale. LoToJa offers 31 different start groups and includes tandems and relay team categories. All categories and classes leave Logan in timed intervals.

To win or even place in a respective LoToJa category is a prestigious achievement. Some past winners have gone on to professional cycling careers, such as Levi Leipheimer and Marty Jemison. Other big name amateur winners over the years include Scott Moninger and John Frey. In addition to being a bicycle race, LoToJa is a fundraising resource for the Huntsman Cancer Foundation, National Ability Center, Utah High School Bicycle League, Golden Moments, and Bike Utah. To date, LoToJa has contributed more than \$3 million to these and other great causes.

LoToJa was created by two avid cyclists, David Bern and Jeff Keller in Logan, Utah who wanted to give Utah racers an idea of what it would be like to compete in a one-day European spring classic like the Tour of Flanders, Paris–Roubaix or Liège–Bastogne–Liège. From 1983 to 1985, LoToJa's distance was 186 miles and the finish line was in the town of Jackson. In 1986, the distance was expanded to over 200 miles and the finish line was moved to Jackson Hole Mountain Resort.

- Public Health Plans:

Complimentary bottled water will be available at the packet pickup area on Friday for those attending the Expo and/or registered applicants "checking in". Portable toilets and wash basins will also be provided in the same area (see Street Festival PDF for setup diagram). Our vendor for this service will be Honey Bucket. We have also placed a trash receptacle and recycle bin from Logan City for disposal of trash. On Saturday, portable toilets are provided on course and placed every 5 to 10 miles from Logan all the way to Jackson.

- Fire Prevention, Emergency Services, and Law Enforcement Plan/Response:

Friday Expo - Logan City Fire Department is one-half block away from our event expo and start line. They will be contacted and alerted in the unlikely event additional services are needed. Logan City Police will also be involved during the event.

Saturday Ride - We have several neutral support volunteers with EMS certification. This includes over 150 HAM radio operators (stationary and mobile) on course providing communications and neutral support with every start pack. Local, county, and state law enforcement have been alerted. Logan City Police Department will provide traffic control and a police escort out of town. Utah Highway Patrol will provide traffic control at key intersections along the race and ride routes to the Utah-Idaho border. County Sheriff's Office as well as North Park and Smithfield Police Departments will be patrolling and providing traffic control. Several Corner and Course Marshals will be placed throughout Cache Valley to provide direction, assist neutral support vehicles, and assist in the event of an accident.

Calling "911" is also an option. Logan Regional, along with every other hospital along LoToJa's race route, will be on alert.

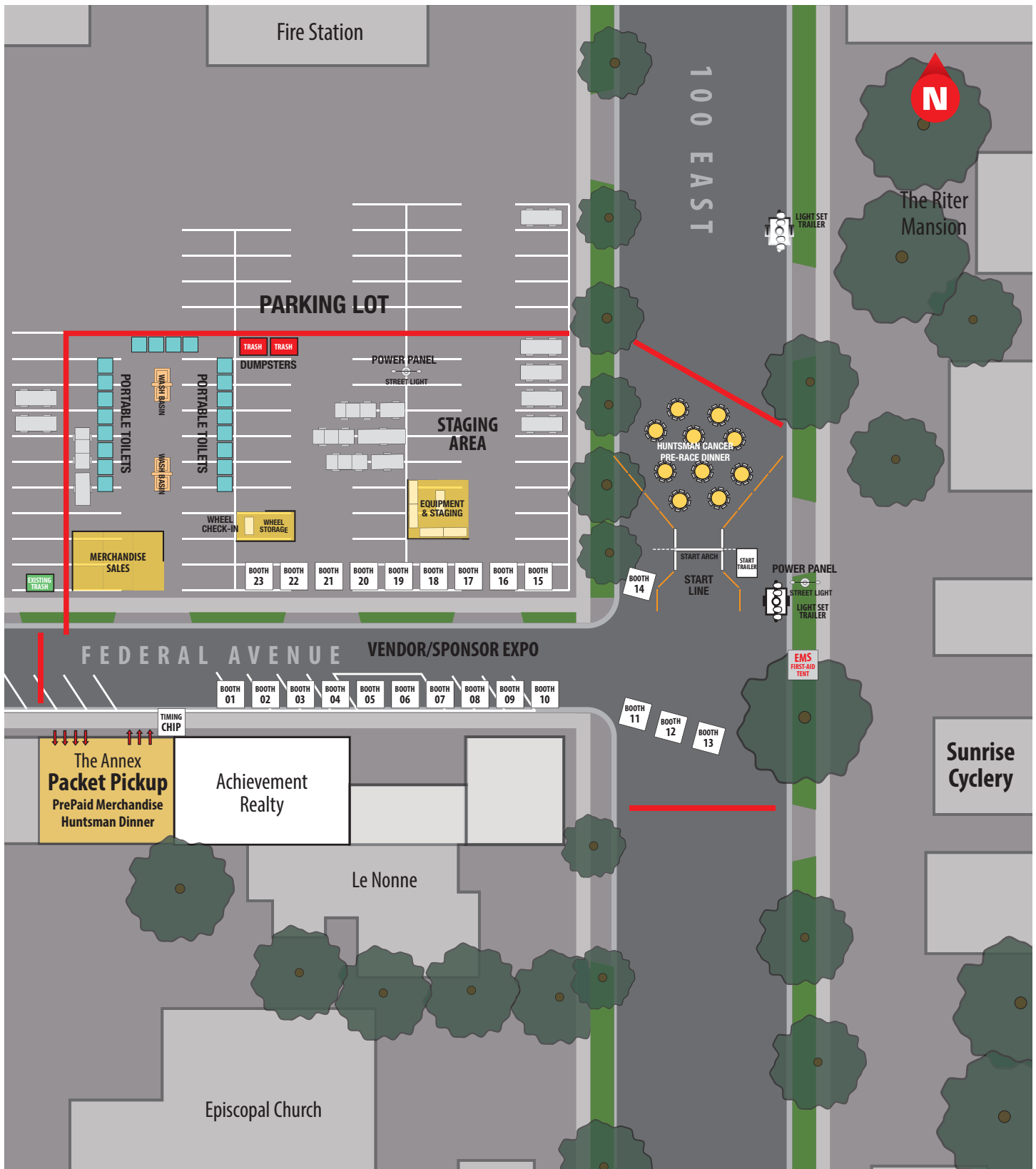
- Admission Fee:

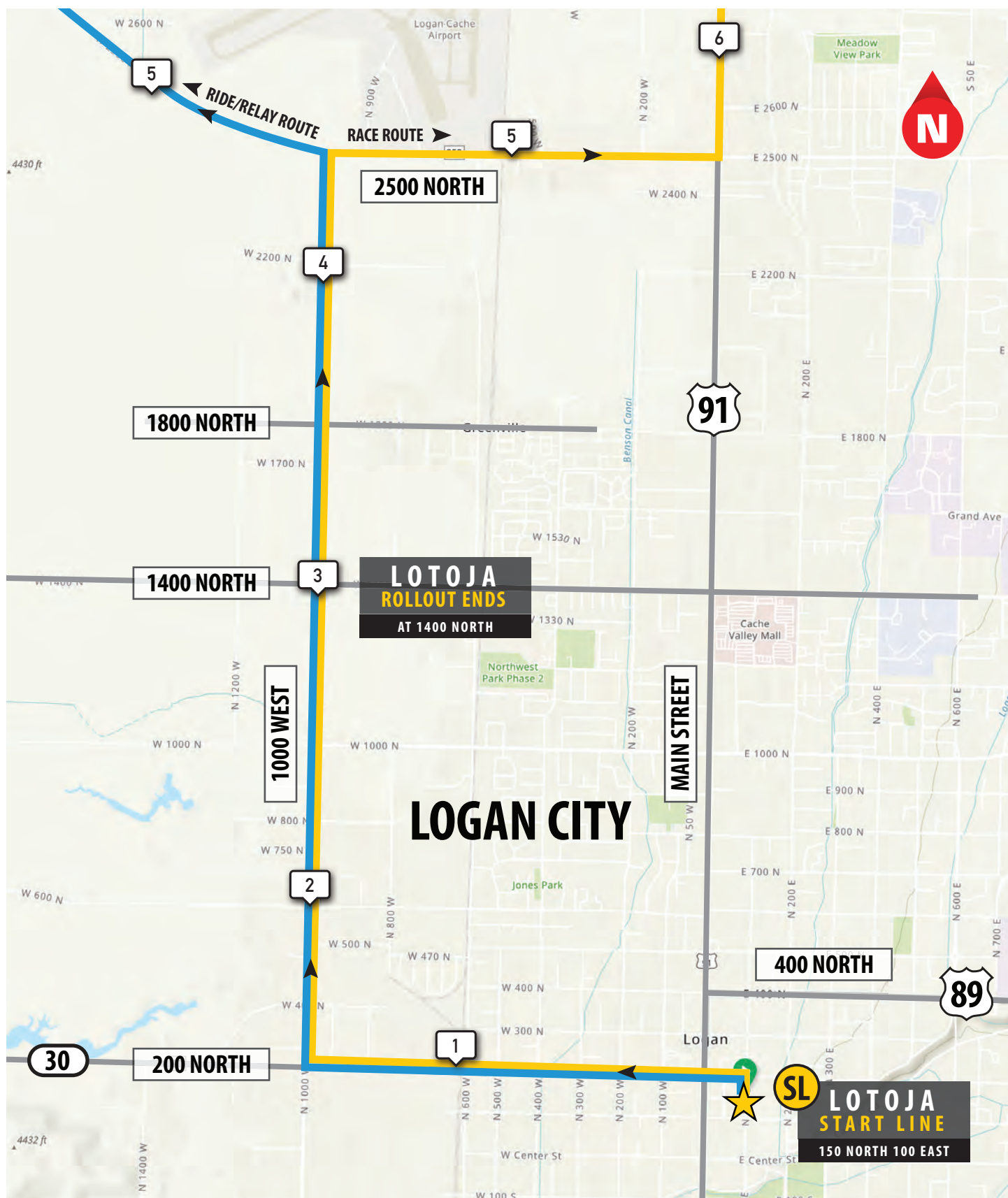

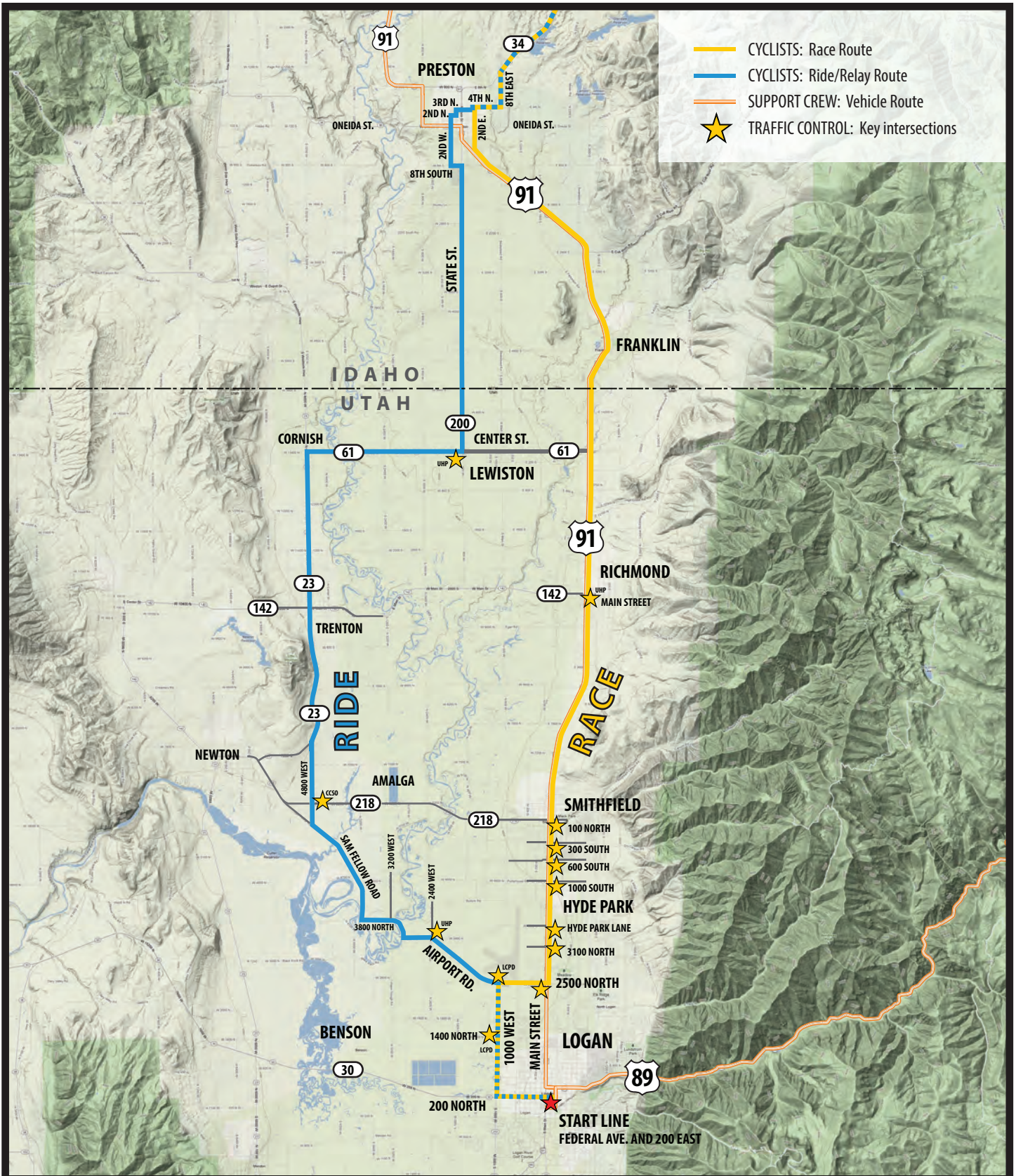

This event is inside of the wildfire season. The roads that are being used and the area that the roads are in could be subjected to closures and evacuation in the event of a wildfire.

In the past there has been a problem in events where cyclist was not yielding to emergency vehicles when they were responding to an emergency.

I would advise that the cyclist and support vehicles be reminded to yield to emergency vehicles and obey all traffic laws.
