G. Hughes, and no other objections or protests have been made or filed.

2. That the objection and protest of the above mentioned party is justified and is hereby allowed.

3. That no petitions for inclusion of lands were presented and that the petition above mentioned for exclusion of land from the said district is based upon facts which would justify such petition being granted and the said petition is hereby granted.

4. That this Board of County Commissioners further finds that the proposed drains, ditches and other works are necessary and will be useful for the drainage of the lands proposed to be drained thereby and which are now being drained for agricultural or sanitary purposes and are conducive to the public health and welfare.

7. That the said Board of Supervisors shall before entering upon the duties of their office, take and subscribe to an oath faithfully to discharge their duties without favor or partiality, and to render a true account of their doings to the County Commissioners by whom they are appointed, whenever required by law or order of the commissioners, which oath shallbe filed with the Clerk and shall each execute an official bond to the District in the sum of \$500.00, hereby fixed by the County Commissioners as a reasonable bond to be furnished by such supervisors, which said bond shall be in the form prescribed by law for the official bond of County Officers.
