Cache County Council 11-12-2019

Chairman Ward opened the Public Hearing and invited public comment.

There was no public comment.

ACTION: Motion by Council member Zilles to close the Public Hearing. Worthen seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous, 7-0.

PENDING ACTION

Resolution No. 2019-34 – Authorizing the issuance and sale of not more than \$12,500,000 aggregate principal amount of Sales Tax Revenue bonds, series 2019; and related matters – Vice Chair Worthen stated the road shop facility plans are too elaborate for her to support. She also expressed concern that all of the road sales tax will be going towards this project instead of to roads. Director Jensen said the bonds will be secured with the road sales tax, but not the full amount of the road sales tax. Only a portion of the road tax will be used to pay back the bonds amounting to between \$600,000 and \$900,000 for repayment leaving \$900,000 to \$1 million for use on roads.

CACHE COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 2019 - 34

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CACHE COUNTY, UTAH (THE "ISSUER"), AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE AND SALE OF NOT MORE THAN \$12,500,000 AGGREGATE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF SALES TAX REVENUE BONDS, SERIES 2019; FIXING THE MAXIMUM AGGREGATE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF THE BONDS, THE MAXIMUM NUMBER OF YEARS OVER WHICH THE BONDS MAY MATURE, THE MAXIMUM INTEREST RATE WHICH THE BONDS MAY BEAR, AND THE MAXIMUM DISCOUNT FROM PAR AT WHICH THE BONDS MAY BE SOLD: RATIFYING THE PUBLICATION OF A NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING; AUTHORIZING THE PUBLICATION OF A NOTICE OF BONDS TO BE ISSUED; PROVIDING FOR THE RUNNING OF A CONTEST PERIOD; AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION BY THE ISSUER OF A SUPPLEMENTAL INDENTURE, AND OTHER **DOCUMENTS** REQUIRED CONNECTION INTHEREWITH: AUTHORIZING THE TAKING OF ALL OTHER ACTIONS NECESSARY TO THE CONSUMMATION OF THE TRANSACTIONS CONTEMPLATED BY THIS RESOLUTION; AND RELATED MATTERS.

WHEREAS, the County Council (the "Council") of Cache County, Utah (the "Issuer") desires to (a) finance all or a portion of the costs of the construction of an expanded Cache County Road and Weed Department facility in Hyrum, Utah, to include an administrative building, a shop building, a weeding building, a roads building, a truck wash facility and a fuel island and for construction of a satellite facility in the northern portion of the County for vehicle, equipment and brine storage and other related improvements (the "Series 2019 Project") and (b) pay costs of issuance with respect to the Series 2019 Bonds herein described; and

WHEREAS, to accomplish the purposes set forth in the preceding recital, and subject to the limitations set forth herein, the Issuer desires to issue its Sales Tax Revenue Bonds, Series 2019 (the "Series 2019 Bonds") (to be issued from time to time, as one or more series and with such other series or title designation(s) as may be determined by the Issuer), pursuant to (a) the Local Government Bonding Act, Title 11, Chapter 14, Utah Code Annotated 1953, as amended (the "Act"), (b) this Resolution, and (c) a General Indenture of Trust dated as of September 1, 2002, as previously supplemented (the "General Indenture"), and a Sixth Supplemental Indenture of Trust dated as of November 1, 2019 (the "Sixth Supplemental Indenture" and together with the General Indenture, the "Indenture"), in substantially the form presented to the meeting at which this Resolution was adopted and which is attached hereto as Exhibit B; and

WHEREAS, the Act provides that prior to issuing bonds, an issuing entity must give notice of its intent to issue such bonds and hold a public hearing to receive input from the public with respect to (i) the issuance of the bonds and (ii) the potential impact that the improvement, facility or property for which the bonds pay all or part of the cost will have on the private sector; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Act, the Issuer desires to ratify the publication of the Notice of Public Hearing and authorize the publication of A Notice Bonds to Be Issued to commence a contestability period; and

WHEREAS, the State of Utah acting through the Permanent Community Impact Fund Board (the "CIB") has offered to purchase the Issuer's Series 2019 Bonds; and

WHEREAS, in order to allow the Issuer, in consultation with the Issuer's Municipal Advisor, Zions Bank Public Finance (the "Municipal Advisor") flexibility in setting the pricing date of the Series 2019 Bonds, the Council desires to grant to any two of (i) any member of the Council, (ii) the County Finance Director or (iii) the County Executive, of the Issuer (together, the "Designated Officers"), the authority to approve the final interest rates, principal amounts, terms, maturities, redemption features, and purchase price at which the Series 2019 Bonds shall be sold, and to make any changes with respect thereto from those terms which were before the Council at the time of adoption of this Resolution, provided such terms do not exceed the parameters set forth for such terms in this Resolution (the "Parameters");

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby resolved by the County Council of Cache County, Utah, as follows:

Section 1. For the purpose of financing the Series 2019 Project and paying costs of issuance of the Series 2019 Bonds, the Issuer hereby authorizes the issuance of the Series 2019 Bonds which shall be designated "Cache County, Utah Sales Tax Revenue Bonds, Series 2019" (to be issued from time to time as one or more series and with such other series or title designation(s) as may be determined by the Issuer) in the initial aggregate principal amount of not to exceed \$12,500,000. The Series 2019 Bonds shall mature in not more than twenty-two (22) years from their date or dates, shall be sold at a price not less than one hundred percent (100%) of the total principal amount thereof, shall bear interest at a rate or rates not to exceed two and one-half percent (2.50%) per annum, and shall be non-callable or subject to redemption, all as shall be approved by the Designated Officers in consultation with the Issuer's Municipal Advisor, all within the Parameters set forth herein.

Section 2. The Sixth Supplemental Indenture in substantially the form presented at this meeting and attached hereto as Exhibit B, is hereby authorized, approved, and confirmed. The County Executive and the Clerk/Auditor (or designee, collectively, the "Clerk/Auditor") are hereby authorized to execute and deliver the Sixth Supplemental Indenture, in substantially the form and with substantially the content as the form presented at this meeting for and on behalf of the Issuer, with final terms as may be established by the Designated Officers, in consultation with the Municipal Advisor, within the Parameters set forth herein, and with such alterations, changes or additions as may be necessary or as may be authorized by Section 3 hereof. The Designated Officers are each hereby authorized to specify and agree as to the final principal amounts, terms, discounts, maturities, interest rates, redemption features, and purchase price with respect to the Series

2019 Bonds for and on behalf of the Issuer by execution of the Supplemental, provided that such terms are within the Parameters set by this Resolution.

Section 3. The appropriate officials of the Issuer are authorized to make any alterations, changes, deletions, or additions to the Sixth Supplemental Indenture, the Series 2019 Bonds or any other document herein authorized and approved which may be necessary to conform the same to the final terms of the Series 2019 Bonds (within the Parameters set by this Resolution), to correct errors or omissions therein, to complete the same, to remove ambiguities therefrom, or to conform the same to other provisions of said instruments, to the provisions of this Resolution or any resolution adopted by the Council or the provisions of the laws of the State of Utah or the United States. The execution thereof by the County Executive on behalf of the Issuer of the documents approved hereby shall conclusively establish such necessity, appropriateness, and approval with respect to all such additions, modifications, deletions, and changes incorporated therein.

Section 4. The form, terms, and provisions of the Series 2019 Bonds and the provisions for the signatures, authentication, payment, registration, transfer, exchange, redemption, and number shall be as set forth in the Indenture. The County Executive and Clerk/Auditor are hereby authorized and directed to execute and seal the Series 2019 Bonds and to deliver said Series 2019 Bonds to the Trustee for authentication. The signatures of the County Executive and the Clerk/Auditor may be by facsimile or manual execution.

Section 5. The appropriate officials of the Issuer are hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver to the Trustee the written order of the Issuer for authentication and delivery of the Series 2019 Bonds in accordance with the provisions of the Indenture.

Section 6. Upon their issuance, the Series 2019 Bonds will constitute special limited obligations of the Issuer payable solely from and to the extent of the sources set forth in the Series 2019 Bonds and the Indenture. No provision of this Resolution, the Indenture, the Series 2019 Bonds, or any other instrument, shall be construed as creating a general obligation of the Issuer, or of creating a general obligation of the State of Utah or any political subdivision thereof, or as incurring or creating a charge upon the general credit of the Issuer or its taxing powers.

Section 7. The appropriate officials of the Issuer, and each of them, are hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver for and on behalf of the Issuer any or all additional certificates, documents and other papers (including, without limitation, escrow agreements or any reserve instrument guaranty agreements permitted by the Indenture) and to perform all other acts they may deem necessary or appropriate in order to implement and carry out the matters authorized in this Resolution and the documents authorized and approved herein.

Section 8. SIXTH SUPPLEMENTAL INDENTURE OF TRUST

This Sixth Supplemental Indenture of Trust, dated as of November 1, 2019, by and between Cache County, Utah, a political subdivision and body politic duly organized and existing under the Constitution and laws of the State of Utah (the "Issuer") and U.S. Bank National Association, a national bank duly organized and existing under the laws of the United States of America, authorized by law to accept and execute trusts and having its principal office in Salt Lake City, Utah (the "Trustee");

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Issuer has entered into a General Indenture of Trust, dated as of June 1, 2002 (the "General Indenture"), with the Trustee; and

WHEREAS, the Issuer desires to issue a Series of Bonds to finance certain improvements as hereinafter set forth; and

WHEREAS, by resolution adopted on October 22, 2019 (the "Parameters Resolution"), the Issuer approved the issuance of not more than \$12,500,000 of Sales Tax Revenue Bonds (the "Authorized Bonds"), established parameters therefor and directed the publication of a "Notice of Public Hearing and Bonds to be Issued"; and

WHEREAS, the issuer has previously issued its Sales Tax Revenue Refunding Bonds, Series 2016 and its Sales Tax Revenue Bonds, Series 2017 (together, the "Parity Bonds"); and

WHEREAS, the Issuer desires to finance all or a portion of the costs of the construction of an expanded Cache County Road and Weed Department facility in Hyrum, Utah, to include an administrative building, a shop building, a weeding building, a roads building, a truck wash facility and a fuel island and for construction of a satellite facility in the northern portion of the County for vehicle, equipment and brine storage and other related improvements (the "Series 2019 Project") by issuing its Sales Tax Revenue Bonds, Series 2019 in the amount of \$12,500,000 (the "Series 2019 Bonds"); and

WHEREAS, the Series 2019 Bonds will be authorized, issued and secured under the General Indenture, as amended and supplemented by this Sixth Supplemental Indenture (the "Sixth Supplemental Indenture," and collectively with the General Indenture, and any amendments thereto or hereto, the "Indenture"); and

WHEREAS, the Permanent Community Impact Fund Board (the "CIB") has agreed to purchase the Series 2019 Bonds upon the terms and conditions herein set forth; and

WHEREAS, the execution and delivery of the Series 2019 Bonds and of this Sixth Supplemental Indenture have in all respects been duly authorized and all things necessary to make the Series 2019 Bonds, when executed by the Issuer and authenticated by the Trustee, the valid and binding legal obligations of the Issuer and to make this Sixth Supplemental Indenture a valid and binding agreement have been done;

NOW, THEREFORE, THIS SIXTH SUPPLEMENTAL INDENTURE OF TRUST WITNESSETH, that to secure the Series 2019 Bonds and all Additional Bonds issued and Outstanding under the Indenture, the payment of the principal or redemption price thereof and interest thereon, the rights of the Registered Owners of the Bonds and of all Reserve Instrument Providers and the performance of all of the covenants contained in such Bonds and herein, and for and in consideration of the mutual covenants herein contained and of the purchase of such Bonds by the Registered Owners thereof from time to time and the issuance of the Reserve Instrument by the Reserve Instrument Provider, and of the acceptance by the Trustee of the trusts hereby created, and intending to be legally bound hereby, the Issuer has executed and delivered this Sixth Supplemental Indenture of Trust, and by these presents does, in confirmation of the General Indenture, as amended and supplemented, hereby sell, assign, transfer, set over and pledge unto U.S. Bank National Association, as Trustee, its successors and trusts and its assigns forever, to the extent provided in the General Indenture, as amended and supplemented, all right, title and interest of the Issuer in and to (i) the Revenues (as defined in the General Indenture), (ii) all moneys in funds and accounts held by the Trustee under the General Indenture and hereunder (except the Rebate Fund), and (iii) all other rights granted under the General Indenture and hereinafter granted for the further securing of such Bonds.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the Trustee and its successors in trust hereby created and its and their assigns forever;

IN TRUST, NEVERTHELESS, FIRST, for the equal and ratable benefit and security of all present and future Registered Owners of Bonds without preference, priority, or distinction as to lien or otherwise (except as otherwise specifically provided), of any one Bond over any other Bond, and SECOND, for the equal and proportionate benefit, security and protection of all Reserve Instrument Providers, without privilege, priority or distinction as to the lien or otherwise of any Reserve Instrument Repayment Obligation over any of the others by reason of time of issuance, delivery or expiration thereof or otherwise for any cause whatsoever.

ARTICLE I

SUPPLEMENTAL INDENTURE; DEFINITIONS

Section 1.1 <u>Supplemental Indenture</u>. This Sixth Supplemental Indenture is supplemental to and is executed in accordance with and pursuant to Articles II and IX of the General Indenture.

Section 1.2 <u>Uniform Definitions</u>. All terms which are defined in the General Indenture, shall have the meanings, respectively, herein (including the use thereof in the recitals and the granting clauses thereof) unless expressly given a different meaning or unless the context clearly otherwise requires. All terms used herein which are defined in the recitals hereto shall have the meanings therein given to the same unless the context requires otherwise and, in addition, the following terms shall have the meanings specified below.

Section 1.3 <u>Additional Definitions</u>. In addition, for purposes of the General Indenture and this Sixth Supplemental Indenture, the following terms shall, unless the context clearly requires otherwise, have the meanings as follows:

"CIB" means, the Permanent Community Impact Fund Board.

"Interest Payment Date" with respect to the Series 2019 Bonds, means each October 1 beginning October 1, 2021.

"Original Issue Date" means with respect to the Series 2019 Bonds, their initial delivery date.

"Parity Bonds" means, the Issuer's Sales Tax Revenue Refunding Bonds, Series 2016 and Sales Tax Revenue Bonds, Series 2017.

"Series 2019 Construction Account" means the account established within the Construction Fund under the General Indenture held in trust by the Trustee, into which the net proceeds of the Series 2019 Bonds shall be deposited as provided herein.

"Series 2019 Bonds" means the Issuer's \$12,500,000 Sales Tax Revenue Bonds, Series 2019, herein authorized.

"Series 2019 Debt Service Reserve Requirement" means, with respect to the Series 2019 Bonds, an initial amount of \$802,425, which shall be funded as provided in Section 4.3 herein.

"Series 2019 Debt Service Reserve Account" means the account established within the Debt Service Reserve Fund under the General Indenture held in trust by the Trustee.

"Series 2019 Project" means the Project financed by the Series 2019 Bonds as described in Exhibit A attached hereto.

ARTICLE II

ISSUANCE OF THE SERIES 2019 BONDS

Section 2.1 Principal Amount, Designation and Series. The Series 2019 Bonds are hereby authorized for issuance under the Indenture for the purpose of providing funds to (a) finance the Series 2019 Project and (b) pay costs incurred in connection with the issuance of the Series 2019 Bonds. The Series 2019 Bonds shall be limited to \$12,500,000 in aggregate principal amount, shall be issued (i) if issued as a State Bond, in the form set forth in Exhibit B-1 and (ii) if issued as an Exchange Bond, in the form set forth in Exhibit B-2 in fully registered form. The Series 2019 Bonds shall bear interest from their Original Issue Date at the rate of 2.50% per annum on the unpaid principal balance of the Series 2019 Bonds which shall be payable commencing October 1, 2021 until the Series 2019 Bonds are paid in full. If issued as Exchange Bonds, the Series 2019 Bonds shall be in the denomination of \$1,000 or any integral multiple thereof. The Series 2019 Bonds shall initially be issued as one fully registered State Bond. The Series 2019 Bonds shall be designated as and shall be distinguished from the Bonds of all other series by the title, "Cache County, Utah Sales Tax Revenue Bonds, Series 2019."

The Series 2019 Bonds shall be issued on a parity with the Issuer's Parity Bonds, such that the Series 2019 Bonds are secured by an equal lien pledge of the Revenues with said Parity Bonds.

Section 2.2 <u>Date, Payment Dates, and Interest</u>. The Series 2019 Bonds shall be in the denomination of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000) each or any integral multiple thereof and shall be paid as provided in this Section 2.2.

The Series 2019 Bonds shall be dated as of the Original Issue Date, and shall be payable in installment payments on October 1 in the years and in the amounts and shall bear interest at the rate of 2.50% per annum (interest accruing beginning October 1, 2020) as follows:

The interest on Series 2019 Bonds so payable, and punctually paid and duly provided for, on any Interest Payment Date will be paid to the Registered Owner thereof at the close of business on the Regular Record Date for such interest. Any such interest not so punctually paid or duly provided for shall forthwith cease to be payable to the registered owner of any Series 2019 Bonds on such Regular Record Date, and may be paid to the registered owner thereof at the close of business on a Special Record Date for the payment of such defaulted interest to be fixed by the Trustee, notice thereof to be given to such registered owner not less than ten days prior to such Special Record Date. The principal of and premium, if any, on the Series 2019 Bonds are payable upon presentation and surrender thereof at the principal corporate trust office of the Trustee. Interest shall be paid by check or draft mailed on each Interest Payment Date to the Holder of each of the Series 2019 Bonds as the name and address of such Holder appears on the Record Date in the Register. Interest on the Series 2019 Bonds shall be calculated on the basis of a 360-day year consisting of twelve 30-day months.

Section 2.3 <u>Delinquent Payment</u>. Payments of principal and interest on the Series 2019 Bonds which are delinquent from the due date thereof shall draw interest at the rate of eighteen percent (18%) per annum on the delinquent payment from said due date until paid in full.

Section 2.4 Exchange of State Bonds. As long as the CIB is the sole Registered Owner of the Series 2019 Bonds, the Series 2019 Bonds shall be issued only as the State Bonds in the form prescribed in Exhibit B-1. It is recognized that the CIB may sell or otherwise transfer the Series 2019 Bonds pursuant to the provisions of the State Financing Consolidation Act, Title 63B, Chapter 1b, Utah Code Annotated 1953, as amended, or otherwise. In the event the CIB determines to sell or otherwise transfer all or a portion of the Series 2019 Bonds pursuant to the State Financing Consolidation Act, or otherwise, the State Bonds shall be exchanged at the office of the Paying Agent for a like aggregate principal amount of Exchange Bonds in accordance with the provisions of this Section 2.4. Any Series 2019 Bond, or any portion thereof, which is sold or otherwise transferred or liquidated by the CIB pursuant to the State Financing Consolidation Act, or otherwise, shall be in the form of an Exchange Bond prescribed in Exhibit B-2, and shall be executed pursuant to authorization contained in Section 2.6 of the General Indenture. Each principal payment on the State Bonds not previously paid or canceled shall be represented by an equivalent principal amount of Exchange Bonds, in authorized denominations, and of like maturity. The Issuer and its officers shall execute and deliver such documents and perform such acts as may reasonably be required by the Issuer to accomplish the exchange of the State Bonds for Exchange Bonds, provided that the CIB shall pay or cause to be paid all costs and other charges incident to such exchange and the Issuer shall have no obligation to pay any such costs or charges.

Section 2.5 <u>Designation of Registrar</u>. U.S. Bank National Association, Salt Lake City, Utah, is hereby designated as Registrar for the Series 2019 Bonds, acceptance of which appointment shall be evidenced by execution of this Sixth Supplemental Indenture by the Trustee.

Section 2.6 <u>Designation of Paying Agent</u>. U.S. Bank National Association, Salt Lake City, Utah, is hereby designated as Paying Agent for the Series 2019 Bonds, acceptance of which appointment shall be evidenced by execution of this Sixth Supplemental Indenture by the Trustee.

Section 2.7 <u>Limited Obligation</u>. The Series 2019 Bonds, together with interest thereon, shall be special limited obligations of the Issuer payable solely from the Revenues (except to the extent paid out of moneys attributable to the Series 2019 Bond proceeds or other funds created hereunder or under the Indenture (excluding the Rebate Fund) or the income from the temporary investment thereof).

Section 2.8 Enforcement of Indenture with Respect to Series 2019 Bonds. Notwithstanding anything in the General Indenture or herein to the contrary, so long as the CIB is the Registered Owner of the Series 2019 Bonds, it may deal directly with the Issuer in the servicing and enforcement of said Series 2019 Bonds; provided, however, prior to undertaking any enforcement activity, it will consult with the Trustee and coordinate any such enforcement with the Trustee to the extent permissible under State regulations, and further provided that no remedial action may be taken by CIB or the Trustee which favors one Bondholder over another.

Section 2.9 Optional Redemption and Redemption Prices. Each principal payment of the Series 2019 Bonds is subject to prepayment and redemption at any time, in whole or in part (if in part, in integral multiples of \$1,000), at the election of the Issuer, in inverse order of the due dates thereof, and by lot selected by the Issuer if less than all of the State Bonds of a particular due date are to be redeemed, upon notice as provided in Section 2.8 of the General Indenture, and upon at least thirty (30) days' prior written notice of the amount of prepayment and the date scheduled for prepayment of the CIB with respect to the State Bonds, and at a redemption price equal to 100% of the principal amount to be prepaid or redeemed, plus accrued interest, if any, to the date of redemption.

Section 2.10 <u>Sale of Series 2019 Bonds</u>. The Series 2019 Bonds are hereby sold to the CIB at a purchase price of \$12,500,000.

Section 2.11 <u>Series 2019 Bonds as Construction Bonds</u>. The Series 2019 Bonds are issued as Additional Bonds to finance a Project under Section 2.13 of the General Indenture. The Issuer hereby certifies that the requirements set forth in Section 2.13 of the General Indenture have been and will be complied with in connection with the issuance of the Series 2019 Bonds.

ARTICLE III

ADDITIONAL COVENANTS

- Section 3.1 <u>Additional Covenants with Respect to the Series 2019 Bonds</u>. The Issuer hereby covenants and agrees with the holder of the Series 2019 Bonds issued hereunder the following:
 - (a) The Issuer covenants that it shall fund and maintain as provided herein all funds referenced herein, until such time as the Series 2019 Bonds have been paid in full.
 - (b) While any of the Series 2019 Bonds remain outstanding and unpaid, any resolution or other enactment of the County Council of the Issuer, applying the Revenues for the payment of the Series 2019 Bonds shall be irrevocable until the Series 2019 Bonds have been paid in full, and shall not be subject to amendment or modification in any manner which would impair the rights of the holders of the Series 2019 Bonds or which would in any way jeopardize the timely payment of principal and interest when due.
 - So long as any Series 2019 Bonds remain outstanding, proper books of record and account will be kept by the Issuer separate and apart from all other records and accounts, showing complete and correct entries of all transactions relating to the receipt and use of the Revenues. Each Bondholder or any duly authorized agent or agents of such holder shall have the right at all reasonable times to inspect all records, accounts and data relating thereto. Except as otherwise provided herein, the Issuer further agrees that it will within one hundred eighty (180) days following the close of each Sinking Fund Year cause an audit of such books and accounts to be made by an independent firm of certified public accountants, showing the receipts and disbursements for account of the Revenues, and that such audit will be available for inspection by the Bondholder; provided, however, during such periods of time as the CIB is the Registered Owner of the State Bonds, each such audit will be supplied to the CIB as soon as completed without prior request therefor by the CIB. The Bondholder may, upon written request from the Issuer setting forth the reasons why a certified audit is not necessary or is impractical, waive the audit requirements for any particular Sinking Fund Year set forth in this Subsection 3.1(c), provided, however, that such waiver shall not apply to the reporting requirements of the Issuer set forth in Subsection 3.1(d) herein.
 - (d) In addition to the reporting requirements set forth in Subsection 4.l(c) above, the Issuer shall submit to the CIB within one hundred eighty (180) days following the close of each Sinking Fund Year, a summary report substantially in the form as provided by the CIB to the Issuer upon purchase of the Series 2019 Bonds.

- (e) If a Bondholder is other than the CIB, the Issuer agrees to furnish a copy of such information to such Bondholder at its request after the close of each Sinking Fund Year. Any Bondholder shall have the right to discuss with the accountant compiling such information the contents thereof and to ask for such additional information as it may reasonably require.
- (f) The Bondholder shall have the right at all reasonable times to inspect the Series 2019 Project, and all records, accounts and data of the Issuer relating thereto, and upon request, the Issuer will furnish to the CIB, financial statements and other information relating to the Issuer and the Series 2019 Project as it may from time to time reasonably require.
- (g) The Issuer will from time to time duly pay and discharge or cause to be paid all taxes, assessments and other governmental charges, if any, lawfully imposed upon the Series 2019 Project, or any part thereof or upon the Revenues, as well as any lawful claims which if unpaid might by law become a lien or charge upon the Series 2019 Project or the Revenues or any part thereof or which might impair the security of the Series 2019 Bonds, except when the Issuer in good faith contests its liability to pay the same.
- (h) All payments falling due on the Series 2019 Bonds shall be made to the Bondholder thereof at par and all charges made by the Depository Bank for its services shall be paid by the Issuer.
- (i) The Issuer will maintain its corporate identity, will make no attempt to cause its corporate existence to be abolished and will resist all attempts by other municipal corporations to annex all or any part of the territory now or hereafter in the Issuer or served by the Series 2019 Project.

Section 3.2 Tax Matters.

- (a) The Issuer shall make no investment or other use of the proceeds of the Series 2019 Bonds at any time during the term thereof which, if such investment or other use had been reasonably expected on the date the Series 2019 Bonds is issued, would have caused the Series 2019 Bonds to be arbitrage bonds within the meaning of Section 148 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, and the regulations promulgated thereunder and shall comply with all the requirements thereof throughout the term of the Series 2019 Bonds.
- (b) The County Executive and the Clerk/Auditor of the Issuer are hereby authorized and directed to execute such certificates as shall be necessary to establish that the Series 2019 Bonds are not "arbitrage bonds" within the meaning of Section 148 of the Code and the Treasury Regulations promulgated or proposed with respect thereto, as the same currently exist, or may from time to time hereafter be amended, supplemented or revised. The Issuer covenants and certifies to and for the benefit of the Registered Owners that no use will be made of the proceeds of the issue and sale of the Series 2019 Bonds, or any funds or accounts of the Issuer

which may be deemed to be gross proceeds of the Series 2019 Bonds, which use, if it had been reasonably expected on the date of issuance of the Series 2019 Bonds, would have caused the Series 2019 Bonds to be classified as "arbitrage bonds" within the meaning of Section 148 of the Code. Pursuant to this covenant, the Issuer obligates itself to comply throughout the term of the Series 2019 Bonds with the requirements of Sections 103 and 141 through 150 of the Code and the regulations proposed or promulgated with respect thereto. The Issuer further represents and covenants that no bonds or other evidences of indebtedness of the Issuer have been or will be issued, sold, or delivered within a period beginning fifteen (15) days prior to the sale of the Series 2019 Bonds and ending fifteen (15) days following the delivery of the Series 2019 Bonds.

Section 3.3 <u>No Additional Priority Bonds</u>. No additional indebtedness, bonds, or notes of the Issuer payable on a priority to the pledge of Revenues for the payment of the Bonds issued under the General Indenture, including the Series 2019 Bonds, shall be created or incurred without the prior written consent of the Owners of 100% of the Outstanding Bonds.

ARTICLE IV

APPLICATION OF PROCEEDS AND FUNDS AND ACCOUNTS

Section 4.1 <u>Application of Proceeds of the Series 2019 Bonds</u>. The Issuer shall deposit with the Trustee the proceeds of the Series 2019 Bonds and the Trustee shall deposit said proceeds into the Series 2019 Construction Account held by the Trustee under the General Indenture. At closing, \$12,500,000 of the proceeds from the sale of the Series 2019 Bonds have been deposited in the Series 2019 Construction Account within the Construction Fund.

Section 4.2 <u>Series 2019 Construction Account.</u> Disbursement of funds shall be made, from the Series 2019 Construction Account, upon receipt of a Form of Requisition signed by the Issuer and the CIB. Disbursements of moneys in the Series 2019 Construction Account shall be made in accordance with the terms of Section 5.2 of the General Indenture upon receipt from the Issuer of an executed Form of Requisition in substantially the form attached hereto as <u>Exhibit D</u>. Each requisition from said Series 2019 Construction Account shall be approved by the qualified representative of the CIB. Notice of each requisition from the Series 2019 Construction Account shall be provided to the CIB. The Costs of Issuance shall be paid by the Trustee from the Series 2019 Construction Account upon receipt from the Issuer of an executed Cost of Issuance Disbursement Request in substantially the form of <u>Exhibit C</u> attached hereto.

Section 4.3 <u>Series 2019 Debt Service Reserve Account</u>. From and after the delivery date of the Series 2019 Bonds, the Issuer shall monthly allocate to the Series 2019 Debt Service Reserve Account within the Debt Service Reserve Fund an amount equal to \$11,145, plus such additional amount as may be required to meet any annual installment to said Account which has not been previously paid in whole or in part, until there shall have been accumulated therein an amount equal to \$802,425, the Series 2019 Debt Service Reserve Requirement with respect to the Series 2019 Bonds.

The moneys on deposit in the Series 2019 Debt Service Reserve Account shall be used and when used, replenished, in accordance with the provisions of the General Indenture.

ARTICLE V

MISCELLANEOUS

- Section 5.1 <u>Confirmation of Sale of Series 2019 Bonds</u>. The sale of the Series 2019 Bonds to the CIB at a price of \$12,500,000 is hereby ratified, confirmed and approved.
- Section 5.2 <u>Severability</u>. If any provision of this Sixth Supplemental Indenture shall be held or deemed to be or shall, in fact, be inoperative or unenforceable as applied in any particular case in any jurisdiction or in all jurisdictions, or in all cases because it conflicts with any other provision or provisions hereof or any constitution or statute or rule of public policy, or for any other reason, such circumstances shall not have the effect of rendering the provision in question inoperative or unenforceable in any other case or circumstance, or of rendering any other provision or provisions herein contained invalid, inoperative, or unenforceable to any extent whatever. The invalidity of any one or more phrases, sentences, clauses or sections in this Sixth Supplemental Indenture contained, shall not affect the remaining portions of this Sixth Supplemental Indenture, or any part thereof.
- Section 5.3 <u>Counterparts</u>. This Sixth Supplemental Indenture may be simultaneously executed in several counterparts, each of which shall be an original and all of which shall constitute but one and the same instrument.
- Section 5.4 <u>Applicable Law</u>. This Sixth Supplemental indenture shall be governed exclusively by the applicable laws of the State of Utah.
- Section 5.5 <u>Effective Date</u>. This Sixth Supplemental Indenture shall become effective immediately upon execution.

ARTICLE VI

CONFIRMATION OF GENERAL INDENTURE

As supplemented by this Sixth Supplemental Indenture, and except as provided herein, the General Indenture is in all respects ratified and confirmed, and the General Indenture, and this Sixth Supplemental Indenture shall be read, taken and construed as one and the same instrument so that all of the rights, remedies, terms, conditions, covenants, and agreements of the General Indenture shall apply and remain in full force and effect with respect to this Sixth Supplemental Indenture, and to any revenues, receipts and moneys to be derived therefrom.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Issuer and the Trustee have caused this Sixth Supplemental Indenture of Trust to be executed as of the date first written above.

ADDITIONAL ACCESS TO COUNTY ROAD 400 EAST (LOCATED IN PROVIDENCE CITY)

WHEREAS, the Cache County Manual of Roadway Design and Construction Standards (Road Manual) §5.6 Access Requirements for Multi-Jurisdictional Development requires that municipal development accessing county roadways must obtain the express written approval of the Cache County Council,

WHEREAS, the proposed multi-jurisdictional access request and Development Services Review (Exhibit A) has been reviewed by the Cache County Council, and;

WHEREAS, the Cache County Council has determined that it is appropriate for the County to permit the proposed multi-jurisdictional access request.

Now, Therefore, Be IT Resolved that the Cache County Council hereby adopts this resolution to allow the proposed multi-jurisdictional access based on the information included in Exhibit A, and on the following conclusions:

- 1. 400 East (100 North & 200 West in Providence) is an existing county roadway with an adequate level of maintenance.
- 2. As identified in the transportation engineer's analysis, the anticipated increase in traffic will not significantly impact the existing roadway and maintenance.
- 3. The County Council has directed that the request for access be approved as Providence City has agreed to maintain the section of county road 1000 East from the Providence City boundary north to the River Heights boundary. Providence City must also enter into a maintenance agreement with the County for the same.

Subject: Multi-Jurisdictional access request

<u>Updated information</u>

This memo has been updated following the County Council meeting on October 8, 2019. The following was referenced, discussed, and proposed by the County Council at that meeting:

Providence City has agreed to take responsibility for the maintenance of 1000 East from the Providence City boundary north to the River Heights Boundary. The Council made reference to this as a balanced exchange with the Jensen Farm request and voted (4 to 3) that the request for access be approved and that a formal maintenance agreement between the County and Providence City be put in place for that section of 1000 East.

This memorandum is issued in response to a multi-jurisdictional access request (Attachment A) made by Danny Macfarlane of Civil Solutions Group, Inc. to allow additional access to county road 400 East (Providence City roadways 100 North & 200 West) for a new 5-lot subdivision within the Providence City limits. The proposed subdivision, Jensen Farm Subdivision (parcel #02-093-0028), would add two driveway accesses on the north frontage (100 North) in addition to an access for an existing single-family residence that is part of the subdivision, and two drive accesses on the west frontage (200 West); both frontages are designated as County Road 400 East at this location in Providence City.

The Cache County Manual of Roadway Design and Construction Standards (Road Manual) §5.6 Access Requirements for Multi-Jurisdictional Development specifies that, "Municipal Development Accessing County Roadways: No municipal development shall be permitted to access a County roadway without the express written approval from the Cache County Council. It is the policy of Cache County that no service shall be provided to municipal developments from County roadways unless extreme circumstances provide no alternative and annexation or acceptance of ownership of the roadway by the municipality is not possible".

As provided by Mr. Macfarlane, an analysis of this potential increase in traffic has been completed by a transportation engineer and identifies the following (See Attachment B):

- 1. The proposed project, with an increase of four single-family residential lots, represents a 0.5% increase in daily vehicle trips to 400 East from the north frontage (100 North in Providence) of the proposed subdivision and a 1% increase for the west frontage (200 West in Providence).
- 2. According to the Wasatch Front Regional Council, a rural two lane arterial has an estimated capacity of 19,500 daily trips; the proposed project will add 38 daily trips with half the trips distributed to the north frontage (100 North) and half to the west frontage (200 West).
- 3. There is sufficient capacity on 400 East (100 North & 200 West Providence) to accommodate the projected increase of 38 daily trips for the project based on the Institute of Transportation Engineers (ITE) *Trip Generation* (9th Edition) Handbook.

4. The existing roads are two lanes with shoulders, but no center turn lanes.

Following the review of the Development Services Office staff and County Council, the recommendation of this office is that the request for the multi-jurisdictional access be approved, as:

- 1. 400 East (100 North & 200 West in Providence) is an existing county roadway with an adequate level of maintenance.
- 2. As identified in the transportation engineer's analysis, the anticipated increase in traffic will not significantly impact the existing roadway and maintenance.
- 3. The County Council has directed that the request for access be approved as Providence City has agreed to maintain the section of county road 1000 East from the Providence City boundary north to the River Heights boundary. Providence City must also enter into a maintenance agreement with the County for the same.

To whom it may concern:

The Jensen Farm Subdivision is being proposed on parcel 02-093-0028 (Approximately 2 acres) located generally at 100 North 200 West in Providence. The proposed subdivision is a 5-lot residential subdivision with all five lots fronting 100 North or 200 West. One of the lots is occupied by a home that exists and already has access to 100 North. This request is for four driveway accesses onto the County road.

Per the Cache County Road Manual section 5.6 Access Requirements for Multi-Jurisdictional Development each development must receive approval by the County Council by written approval to access a County Roadway. The submitted traffic memorandum completed by Traffic Engineer Michael Taylor from Civil Solutions Group detailed that the trips generated by the four new driveways will "not interfere with the operations of 100 North or 200 West" and "there is, therefore, sufficient capacity on these roadways to accommodate the proposed project." It is clear from the traffic analysis that this development will little to no impact on the County roadways. This development has no other possible accesses other than driveway access on the County roadways. The Providence City code does not allow inner block development so a roadway into the parcel is not allowed. The only access allowed per the city code is onto the County roadways.

Section 5.6 of the Cache County Road Manual also states, "it is the policy of Cache County that no service shall be provided to municipal developments from County roadways unless extreme circumstances provide no alternative and annexation or acceptance of ownership of the roadway by the municipality is not possible." As was mentioned above this development has no other option than to access driveways from 100 North and 200 West based upon the zoning regulations in Providence City. This parcel has no other city street or access other than the County roadways. There is no alternative option that would allow another means of access. It is also not possible to annex or accept ownership of the County Roadways by the municipality.

In summary please consider this request for written approval of access from the four residential driveways to the County roadways as outlined in this request. Thank you in advance for your consideration.






Figure 1 Proposed Campbell Annexation




Figure 2 Conflicting Annexation Claims

This memo provies a trip generation analysis for the four additional lots proposed as part of the Jensen Farm Subdivision in Brovidence, UT. The proposed subdivision contains five lots total. An existing residential structure will remain on one of these lots. Figure 1 shows the proposed site location. Figure 2 shows the proposed lot layout.

TRIP GENERATION

Trip generation for the site was calculated using the Institute of Transportation Engineers (ITE) Trip Generation Handbook (9th Edition). On average the four proposed additional lots will generate 3 AM trips, 4 PM trips and 38 trips daily. These values are given in Table 1.

TRIP DISTRIBUTION & ASSIGNMENT

100 North and 200 West are both part of FAR Route 1197. In 2016 100 North carried roughly 3,700 ADT, and 200 West carried roughly 2,000 ADT (values provided by UDOT). Half of the proposed ADT of 38 trips will be distributed onto 100 North and the other half on 200 West (see Figure 2 for lot layout). The proposed project therefore represents a 0.5% increase in traffic to 100 North and a 1% increase for 200 West. Both 100 North and 200 West are two-lane roads with shoulders, but no center turn lanes. According to Wasatch Front Regional Council, a rural two-lane arterial has an estimated capacity of 19,500 daily trips. There is, therefore, sufficient capacity on these roadways to accommodate the proposed project.

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-36 CACHE COUNTY, UTAH

CAMPBELL ANNEXATION

A RESOLUTION TO ALLOW TWO UNINCORPORATED ISLANDS AS PART OF THE CAMPBELL ANNEXATION

WHEREAS, Utah Code Section 10-2-402 requires that in the annexation of unincorporated property, the County must agree to the creation of unincorporated islands; and

WHEREAS, after careful consideration of the findings of fact and conclusions identified in the staff report (Exhibit A), the Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of Cache County to allow the creation of unincorporated islands resulting from the Campbell Annexation; and

Now, Therefore, the County Legislative Body of Cache County agrees to allow the creation of unincorporated islands as a result of the Campbell Annexation as follows:

- 1. The County Council is authorized to act as county legislative body of Cache County; and
- 2. The request has been reviewed by the County Council in conformance with State Code; and
- 3. Logan City is not considering an annexation without a petition and therefore has not adopted a resolution indicating that not annexing the entire unincorporated island is in the municipality's best interest for the entire unincorporated island that has less than 800 residents.
- 4. The impact on county facilities must be addressed as follows:
 - a. The entirety of the right-of-way must be included in the annexation, specifically (see attached map):
 - i. The right-of-way of 2200 South that lies between the existing Logan City boundary on the west, to the east side of the 800 West right-of-way on the east; and
 - ii. The right-of-way of 800 West and Hyclone Road from the intersection of 2200 South on the south to the intersection of Hyclone Road and State Route 89/91 on the north.



To: Cache County Council

Purpose

To review a petition submitted by Del Ray Campbell to Logan City for the annexation of property from unincorporated Cache County to Logan City. As the proposal will create two unincorporated islands from an existing unincorporated island, the Cache County Council must agree to the request for the annexation petition to move forward.

Summary

Cache County has been notified of the petition for property to be annexed from Cache County into Logan City.

The proposal, to annex approximately 25 Acres (Parcel 03-006-0016) from unincorporated Cache County into

Logan City will leave two unincorporated islands behind. Currently a single unincorporated island exists, and the applicant is proposing to annex property in such a way that two unincorporated islands are left as remainders. No territory that isn't already part of an unincorporated island would be created by this request.

Per 10-2-402(1)(b)(iii) of Utah Code, annexation shall not leave an unincorporated island unless:

- The municipal legislative body adopts a resolution that indicates not annexing the entire unincorporated island is in the municipalities best interest & the entire unincorporated island has less than 800 residents (10-2-418(3)).

 OR
- The Municipality and County agree on the leaving of unincorporated island(s).

Conflicting Annexation Claims

The communities of Logan, Nibley, and Millville all have made annexation claims on the unincorporated island, and in many cases parcels are claimed by multiple municipalities as shown below. Both Logan and Millville include the parcel in question within their annexation boundaries.





Figure 3 Logan Annexation Plan






Figure 4 Millville and Nibley Annexation Plans

Findings

- Fewer than 800 residents live within the unincorporated island boundaries.
- As of now the County and the Municipality have not agreed upon the leaving of unincorporated island(s)
- The Municipal Legislative Body has not passed a resolution indicating that leaving the unincorporated islands is in their best interest.
- The proposed annexation is located within the Logan Future Annexation Plan Area.
- Portions of the existing unincorporated island (and both remainder unincorporated islands) are located within the Logan, Nibley, and Millville Future Annexation Plans.
- It may be in the County's best interest that the unincorporated island be annexed by municipalities, and that future development occurs within municipalities.
- Currently 2200 S and 800 W are both Class B Surface roadways, with 2200 South providing a rural

function, while 800 West provides a collector function.

Options

The County Council may follow one of the following courses of action:

- 1) If the council finds that the annexation is appropriate, agree to the annexation.
- 2) Or, Do not agree to the annexation as it leaves two unincorporated islands.

Recommendation

Based on the summary and findings above, staff recommends the County Council find that the annexation is appropriate and agree to the annexation.




Figure 5 County Roadway Functions (Green – Rural; Red – Collector)



CACHE COUNTY RESOLUTION 2019 - 37

A SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING THE DEVASTATING EFFECTS OF THE OPIOID CRISIS AS A PUBLIC NUISANCE

WHEREAS, the Centers for Disease Control has declared that the United States is experiencing an opioid-induced "public health epidemic"; and

WHEREAS, 91 Americans die each day from opioid-related drug overdoses; and

WHEREAS, opioid pain relievers, including oxycodone, hydrocodone, fentanyl, and hydromorphone are responsible for three-fourths of all prescription drug overdose deaths; and

WHEREAS, nearly one in three Utah adults (32%) were prescribed an opioid pain medication in 2014; and

WHEREAS, Utah has the seventh-highest drug overdose rate in the United States with an average of six people dying per week (one death nearly every day) and 24 deaths each month as a result of overdosing on prescription opioids; and

WHEREAS, according to the State Department of Health, the rate of prescription opioids dispensed in Utah from 2002 to 2015 grew by 29.4%, averaging nearly five opioid prescriptions per patient in 2015; and

WHEREAS, since 2002, drug poisoning deaths per 100,000 in population have increased at an alarming rate and prescription opioids have been responsible for more drug deaths in Utah than all other drug categories, such as benzodiazepines, over-the-counter medications, or illicit drugs; and

WHEREAS, drug poisoning deaths are a preventable public health problem that has outpaced deaths from firearms, falls, and motor vehicle crashes in Utah since 2002; and

WHEREAS, Cache County is experiencing opioid-related deaths at the same pace as the rest of Utah; and

WHEREAS, there are significant economic impacts caused by the opioid epidemic – \$55 billion in health and social costs, and \$20 billion in emergency department and inpatient care; and

WHEREAS, counties often bear the brunt of these costs, paying both for the treatment and incarceration of addicted persons and the deep social cost that the loss of a significant population of productive community members has in the region; and

WHEREAS, the North American prescription opioid market exploded to a value of \$12.4 billion in 2015 with an expected annual growth rate of 4.6%; and



WHEREAS, prescription opioid manufacturers realized these profits as thousands of individuals lost their lives, having fallen victim to prescription opioid addictions; and

WHEREAS, practices of manufacturers, distributors, and sellers of opioid painkillers have contributed to the epidemic; and

WHEREAS, beginning in the 1990s, opioid manufacturers lied to both doctors and the public about the risks of opioids and touted them as a non-addictive and safer alternative to other drugs; meanwhile, opioid distributors injected millions upon millions of opioid pills into small communities, far in excess of any reasonable need, including injecting over 18,000,000 opioid pills into Cache County during the seven-year period from 2006 to 2012; and

WHEREAS, as a direct consequence of over-distribution, addiction has become commonplace, with death often the ultimate consequence; hard-working Americans have become addicts, first to the opioids pushed by the drug makers and distributors, and then to street drugs like heroin; and

WHEREAS, drug companies and distributors have spent millions of dollars on promotional activities and materials that falsely deny or trivialize the risks of opioids while overstating the benefits of using them for long-term chronic pain, including providing funding to prominent doctors, medical societies, and patient advocacy groups to win their support for the drugs' use for chronic pain; and

WHEREAS, serious allegations have been raised that prescription opioid manufacturers have systematically engaged in deceptive marketing practices and fraudulent cover-ups to advance the sale of prescription opioids; and

WHEREAS, Cache County resolved in Resolution 2018 - 12 to pursue legal action against drug manufacturers and distributors of opioids, including under the legal theory of abating a public nuisance.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that:

<u>Section 1</u>: The purpose and intent of this resolution, together with Resolution 2018 - 12, is to allow Cache County to recover the costs to the County of the opioid epidemic from the opioid makers and distributors who are responsible for those costs and to declare the opioid epidemic and its effects on the County a public nuisance.

<u>Section 2</u>: To accomplish this, the County hereby declares the opioid epidemic and its effect on the County a public nuisance. Specifically, the excessive selling, distributing, and prescribing of prescription opioid pain pills is a hazard to public health and safety, which has created a public nuisance to the citizens of Cache County, and that nuisance remains unabated.



<u>Section 3</u>: This resolution applies retroactively and amends and supersedes the language of Cache County Resolution 2019-33.
