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#### CACHE COUNTY COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

March 11, 1997

The Cache County Council met in regular session on the 11th day of March, 1997 in the County Council Chambers located at 120 North 100 West, Logan, Utah 84321.

#### ATTENDANCE

Council Chairman Darrel L. Gibbons and Vice Chairman C. Larry Anhder were present. Council members present were: Sarah Ann Skanchy, H. Craig Petersen, Guy Ray Pulsipher, Cory Yeates and Layne M. Beck.

Others present were: County Executive M. Lynn Lemon, County Clerk, Stephen M. Erickson, County Attorney, Scott Wyatt, County Auditor, Tamra Stones, County Executive Assistant, Mike Nilson, Sesquicentennial Parade Representatives, Paul Montrose and Wade Andrews, members of the local news media and other interested citizens.

#### CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Darrel L. Gibbons called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. and welcomed all who were in attendance.

#### INVOCATION

The invocation was given by Councilman Guy Ray Pulsipher.

#### AGENDA & MINUTES

The meeting agenda was adjusted to place item (a) to section 11 (other business) a discussion on Roads-2477. The agenda was reviewed and approved.

The minutes of the regular Council meeting held on February 25, 1997 and sent to all members of the Council were corrected and approved.

#### REPORT OF THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE

The County Executive M. Lynn Lemon reported on the following items:

1. Resolution No. 97-08: Environmental Certifying Officer for County CDBG Construction Projects.

Executive Lemon told the Council that the County sponsored CDGB projects are required to have a Environment Certifying Officer. Resolution No. 97-08 authorizes the appointment of Jay Aguilar from the Bear River Association of Governments to be that Officer.

It was moved by Vice Chairman Anhder to adopt Resolution No. 97-08. It was seconded and carried unanimously.

2. Warrants: The warrants for the following periods were presented to the County Clerk for filing: 02/21/97 to 02/27/97 & 02/28/97 to 03/06/97.

#### PARADE: SESQUICENTENNIAL JULY 24, 1997

Organizers of a Sesquicentennial Parade on the 24th of July, 1997, in Logan, Paul Montrose and Wade Andrews appeared before the Council to invite the county's participation in the parade. Montrose said that they want to honor the pioneers who came to area 150 years ago. The Cache Mayors Association and the Cache Chamber of Commerce are backing the event. The organizers are asking for funding and county involvement to help with the parade.

#### PUBLIC HEARING SET: BUDGET OPENING-1997

A public hearing is necessary to receive public comment on making adjustments to the 1997 budget.

Councilman Skanchy moved to set the Public Hearing at 6:00 p.m. on March 25, 1997 in the Council Chambers. It was seconded and carried unanimously.

#### PUBLIC HEARING CONTINUED: BUDGET OPENING-1997

The County Auditor, Tamra Stones reviewed the changes made in the 1997 budget as recommended during the public hearing that was held during the last Council meeting on February 25, 1997. The changes were presented in resolution form.

#### RESOLUTION NO. 97-05: BUDGET ADJUSTMENTS-1997

The adoption of Resolution No. 97-05 will approve the recommended changes to the 1997 budget.

It was moved by Councilman Skanchy to adopt Resolution No. 97-

05. It was seconded and carried unanimously.

THE COUNCIL ADJOURNED FROM THE REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING INTO A BOARD OF EQUALIZATION.

#### BOARD OF EQUALIZATION: PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTION REQUESTS

The Board reviewed a number of property tax exemption applications including a request from Logan Regional Hospital. The Board tabled the Hospital's request and assigned a committee to meet with them to further study the issue.

Board member Anhder moved to create a sub-committee to meet with the Hospital. The committee would include the County Auditor. The motion was seconded and carried unanimously.

Board Chairman Gibbons appointed members Skanchy, Yeates and Tamra Stones, the County Auditor as the committee to meet with the Hospital.

The following nine (9) applications were presented for exemption for religious purposes as follows: The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints, Bible Evangelical Free Fellowship Church, Christian Center, American Islamic Trust, Roman Catholic Church, Maranatha Baptist Church, Episcopal Church, Presbyterian Church, Jehovah's Witnesses.

Board member Anhder moved to approve the above mentioned requests. It was seconded and carried unanimously.

Bear River Mental Health.

Board member Anhder moved to approve the request from the Bear River Mental Health. It was seconded and carried unanimously.

Bridgerland Audubon Society.

Board member Anhder moved to waive the rules of first & second reading and approve this application. It was seconded and carried unanimously.

Association for the Advancement of the Handicapped

Board member Yeates moved to approve this application. It was seconded and passed on a vote of 6 "Yes" to 1 "No" vote. Skanchy voted no because they do not own any taxable property.

Cache Employment & Training Center. (formally known as Cache Industries)

Board member Skanchy moved to approve this request. It was seconded and carried unanimously.

American Red Cross Cache County Chapter.

A motion to approve this application was made by Board member Anhder. It was seconded and carried unanimously.

Options for Independence.

A motion to approve this application was made by Board member Yeates. It was seconded and carried unanimously.

American Legion Post #58 (Smithfield).

A hearing to hear appeals from the Smithfield Legion, who had there application denied last meeting had been scheduled for this meeting. However, after proper notification, the Legion had no representation at this meeting. The prior decision to deny this application will remain the same.

Sunshine Terrace Foundation.

It was moved by Board member Skanchy to approve this request. It was seconded and carried unanimously.

Whittier Community Center.

It was moved by Board member Skanchy to approve the application. It was seconded and passed on a vote of 6 "Yes" to 1

"No". Board member Anhder voted "No".

Faith & Fellowship Center.

(See attachment #12)

Board member Yeates moved to deny this application. It was seconded and carried unanimously.

Community Nursing Service.

This application was tabled until further information is obtained by the Auditor.

The Board set a hearing to hear any appeals from the Faith & Fellowship Center and Community Nursing Service. The hearings were scheduled for 5:30 p.m. March 25, 1997.

Somebody's Attic.

Board Skanchy moved to approve this application. It was seconded and carried unanimously.

A MOTION TO ADJOURN FROM THE BOARD OF EQUALIZATION BACK INTO THE REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING WAS MADE BY BOARD MEMBER SKANCHY. IT WAS SECONDED AND CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

#### RESOLUTION NO. 97-07: JAIL INMATE EXCHANGE

Executive Lemon reviewed a proposed resolution from the County Sheriff that would allow exchanging inmates with Salt Lake County. The resolution was tabled until further information is obtained. Executive Lemon will follow up on the proposal.

#### PLAT APPROVAL-FINAL: CRONQUIST MINOR SUBDIVISION

The Council tabled this agenda item until the next Council meeting.

#### BUILDING SALE-170 NORTH MAIN-BRAG: DISCUSSION

Executive Lemon, told the Council that he has been reviewing a possible sale of the County owned building, at 170 North Main to BRAG. Two options have been considered: 1. To sell the building for \$200,000 and rent back from BRAG space for the County Clerk or 2. Agreed not to sell the building to BRAG, but keep ownership, and

allow BRAG to use the rent they now pay to the County to up grade the building. Lemon reported that the BRAG Governing Board had approved a motion to purchase the building for not more than \$225,000. The vote was 6 to 2 in favor of the purchase with Cache County members abstaining. Lemon also said that the County appraisers have put the same value on the building as appraised by BRAG. A finance statement prepared by the County Auditor on the building was discussed.

Executive Lemon asked Council members for their opinion concerning the sale. Vice Chairman Anhder said that the time to sell is when we have a buyer. Chairman Gibbons said that he isn't so sure that, if it comes down to it, the BRAG Governing Board would approve purchasing the building. Lemon said that if we use the BRAG for improving the building he thinks that the County could sell the building for more money at a later date if needed. Chairman Gibbons and Councilman Skanchy both stated that they are not if favor of selling the building at the present time.

#### RESTAURANT TAX GUIDELINE CHANGES: ANHDER, LARRY

Vice Chairman Anhder is proposing a change in the allocation process of the County assessed Restaurant Tax. Anhder is suggesting two additions to the process and presented those additions for initial consideration.

Anhder is proposing that more of the Restaurant Tax money be spent on needs at the County Fairgrounds including promotion of the Fair and the Great American West Rodeo.

#### ROADS- 2477 COUNTY: DISCUSSION

Vice Chairman Anhder is recommending that the County become more aware of the 2477 roads in the County. The 2277 roads once thought to be on BLM public lands only, are now also thought to be on Forest Service roads. The 2477 County roads in Cache County are all in the Forest Service areas. The concern is that other Counties are having problems with the BLM taking over the 2477 roads and not allowing Counties right-of-way on those roads. It has been recommended that the County begin to establishing proof of use through documentation. Executive Lemon will follow up on the issue.

#### COUNCIL MEMBER REPORTS

Councilman Skanchy: Reported that she has be appointed Vice Chairman of the Regional Work Force Council. The Work Force Council is in the process of appointing additional members.

Councilman Petersen: Petersen introduced Maridene Alexander, who directs the Bridgerland Travel Region and who is also a member of the County Convention Center Task Force. Alexander reported that the Task Force has been meeting with concerned individuals on the proposed Convention Center. Meetings are continuing and a full recommendation from the Task Force will be made at the next Council meeting.

Councilman Yeates: Some members of the County Planning Commission are wondering why the Council gave the proposed Land Use Plan back to them for review. The Planning Commission is now meeting every Monday to further study the Land Use Plan.

Executive Lemon: Told the Council that Cache Mayor's Association have invited them to attend their next meeting along with State Legislatures. Council members will be asked to buy their own meal.

#### ADJOURNMENT

No further business was presented and Chairman Gibbons adjourned the meeting at 7:00 p.m.
