CACHE COUNTY  
ORDINANCE NO. 2006-06

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE VEHICLE AND TRAFFIC ORDINANCE,  
TITLE 10, CACHE COUNTY CODE.

Whereas, Cache County is experiencing significant air quality problems, particularly during winter inversions related to PM 2.5; and,

Whereas, the Bear River Health Department and Cache County have jointly appointed an Air Quality Task Force to further investigate the problem and develop alternative solutions; and,

Whereas, the Bear River Health Department, in conjunction with the State of Utah, has retained various experts and conducted an extensive investigation of the cause of said air quality problems; and,

Whereas, the cause of said problems are related to the topography of Cache Valley and the presence and interaction of motor vehicles and large animal husbandry; and,

Whereas, Cache County has received a number of recommendations to deal with this problem including plans to curtail wintertime driving during inversions and diminish exposures to harmful air conditions; and,

Whereas, it is apparent that Cache County will need to expend public funds to further investigate the causes and possible remedial actions to take to diminish the air quality problems; and,

Whereas, it is also apparent that Cache County will need to expend additional funds to encourage the public to curtail driving automobiles during inversions; and,

Whereas, it is also apparent that Cache County should expend funds to educate and encourage the public how to protect their health during those periods where air quality problems exist; and,

Whereas, Cache County believes the most appropriate method to collect the funds necessary is to place in effect a motor vehicle and air pollution fee on the registration of motor vehicles.

NOW THEREFORE the County Council of Cache County, Utah, in regular meeting, lawful notice of which has been given, hereby amends the Cache County Traffic Code by ordaining and adopting a Motor Vehicles and Air Pollution Fee as follows:

CHAPTER 10.20

**MOTOR VEHICLES AND AIR POLLUTION FEE**

SECTION: 1

10.20.010 Air Quality Control Fee

10:20.010

- A. **AIR QUALITY CONTROL FEE:** The following fee is assessed upon every motor vehicle registered in Cache County annually at the time of registration of the vehicle: Air Quality Control Fee of Two dollars. (\$2.00)
- B. "Motor vehicle" means and includes aircraft, motorcycles, off highway vehicles, passenger vehicles, snowmobiles, trucks, recreational vehicles, motorized water craft, motorized farm equipment or any other motorized vehicle subject to state registration.


SECTION: 2

This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon publication, in the manner required by law.


