Cache County Councilmember Barbara Tidwell Announces Resignation Effective December 31, 2025

Cache County — Cache County Councilmember **Barbara Tidwell** has announced that she will resign from her position effective **December 31, 2025**, concluding nearly a decade of dedicated service to the citizens of Cache County.

Councilmember Tidwell was first elected in **November 2016** and has been a consistent and steady voice on the Council for nine years. Over the past four years, she has served in key leadership roles as **either Chair or Vice Chair of the Council**, helping guide the body through periods of growth, transition, and significant countywide initiatives.

“Barbara has been a thoughtful leader, a tireless advocate for her constituents, and a trusted voice on the Council,” said county officials. “Her commitment to public service and her deep love for this community have been evident in everything she has done.”

During her time on the Council, Tidwell contributed to major efforts including long-term strategic planning, improved county operations, land-use and open space preservation work, and enhanced transparency and accessibility for residents. Colleagues describe her as collaborative, approachable, and unafraid to tackle difficult issues with both humility and resolve.

Her resignation marks the end of a chapter defined by steady leadership, institutional knowledge, and genuine care for Cache County’s future. The Council extends its sincere gratitude for her years of service and wishes her the very best in her next endeavors.
