Heroes Tribute Ride for the Fallen & America250 Event in Cache County

Logan, Utah: On Saturday, August 23, 2025, the American Heroes Motorcycle Association UT1 will host the Heroes' Tribute & Ride for the Fallen at Elk Ridge Park in North Logan, Utah. Registration opens at 8:00 a.m., followed by a memorial ceremony at 10:00 a.m., with kickstands up at 10:30 a.m. The ride honors the memory of LCpl Michael J. Allred and all fallen heroes, uniting participants and community members in remembrance and gratitude.

The weekend will begin with a banquet dinner on Friday, August 22 at 6:00 p.m. at the Riverwoods Conference Center in Logan. "This event is about more than the ride—it's about honoring the sacrifices of our fallen heroes and standing together as a community to keep their memories alive," said Wally Odd, President of the Rocky Mountain Veterans Center Board of Directors and Chair of the Heroes Tribute event.
