CACHE COUNTY EXECUTIVE ACCEPTING APPLICATIONS FOR NEW CACHE OPEN SPACE ADVISORY COMMITTEE

LOGAN, UTAH – Cache County Executive David Zook today announced that he is accepting applications for the new Cache Open Space Advisory Committee (COSAC). The committee comes as a result of the passing of the ballot proposition “Cache County Open Space Bond” in the 2022 General Election.

Cache County voters approved a \$20 Million Open Space Bond for the purpose of paying all or a portion of the costs of purchasing land, conservation easements, and other interests in land from willing landowners in order to protect scenic vistas, preserve open lands near valley gateways, add trails and trail connectivity, and maintain agriculture, waterways, and wildlife habitat, with all acquisitions to be selected by the Cache County Council based upon recommendations of the Open Space Advisory Committee.

“I’m excited that the voters supported our proposal to preserve open space in Cache County,” said Cache County Executive, David Zook. “We’re looking forward to bringing more citizens to the table now to help us implement that plan.”
