ANDERSON</p>	<p>Shall Cache County, Utah, be authorized to issue General Obligation Bonds in a principal amount not to exceed TWENTY MILLION DOLLARS for the purpose of paying all or a portion of the costs of purchasing land, conservation easements, and other interests in land from willing landowners in order to protect scenic vistas, preserve open lands near valley gateways, add trails and trail connectivity, and maintain agriculture, waterways, and wildlife habitat, with all acquisitions to be selected by the County Council based upon recommendations of an Open Lands Board and subject to periodic independent audit commissioned by the County; said Bonds to be due and payable in not to exceed 20 years from the date of issuance of the Bonds?</p>	<p>Shall the Utah Constitution be amended to change a provision relating to special sessions of the Utah Legislature that are convened by the president of the Utah Senate and speaker of the Utah House of Representatives:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • to increase the limit on the total amount of money the Legislature may appropriate during the session from an amount equal to 1% of the total amount appropriated during the preceding fiscal year to an amount equal to 5% of the total amount appropriated during the preceding fiscal year; and • to exclude from that 5% limit: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • an appropriation of money that the state receives from the federal government to address a fiscal, public health, or other emergency or crisis; and • an appropriation that decreases the amount of money previously authorized to be spent. <p><input type="radio"/> FOR <input type="radio"/> AGAINST</p>
<p>JUDICIAL RETENTION</p> <p>Visit judges.utah.gov to learn about the Judicial Performance Evaluation Commission's recommendations for each judge</p>	<p><u>Property Tax Cost of Bonds:</u> If the Bonds are issued as planned, an annual property tax sufficient to pay debt service on the Bonds will be required over a period of 20 years in the estimated amount of \$26.85 per year on a \$429,000 primary residence and in the estimated amount of \$45.52 on a business property of the same value.</p>	<p>The foregoing information is only an estimate and is not a limit on the amount of taxes that the County may be required to levy to pay debt service on the Bonds. The County would be obligated to levy taxes to the extent provided by law in order to pay the Bonds. No such contest shall be maintained unless a complaint meeting the requirements of applicable law is filed with the Clerk of the District Court of Cache County within the prescribed 40-day period.</p>
